MacQuesten Chosen by City to Construct New Multipurpose Tower in New Rochelle

selected MacQuesten Development LLC to design and construct the city's newest 27-story, mixed-use tower. The real estate development company was chosen to be the team behind the \$120 million construction project after a competitive process. The new building will include 282 residential units — with apartments ranging in size from 425 to 1,200 square feet — about 9,500 square feet of ground-level retail space, a four-story parking garage, and room to build 50,000 square feet of office space, if desired. The site of the new tower is currently home to New Rochelle's downtown fire station #1. However, MacQuesten will work with architectural firm Mitchell and Associates to design a new firehouse at an alternate, off-site location.
